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3	AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LITTLE ROCK, ARK., REV. CODE
4	CHAPTER 30 (1988), TO PROVIDE FOR A DEFERRAL OF MASTER
5	STREET PLAN RIGHT-OF-WAY DEDICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR
6	SOUTH UNIVERSITY AVENUE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
9	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
0	Section 1. Chapter 30 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to provide for a deferral of certain
1	requirements within the Master Street Plan along South University Avenue for the Mini-Warehouse
2	Conditional Use Permit (Z-4578-B), located at 1203-1205 South University Avenue.
3	Section 2. Chapter 30 Article VI requiring developers to dedicate right of way to the requirements o
4	the Master Street Plan will be deferred along the east side of South University Avenue until such time as i
5	the exterior wall configuration of the existing building is changed; or ii) the existing building is demolished
6	and a new building constructed. The specific deferral is for dedication of right-of-way of width o
7	approximately nine (9) feet in width for approximately 370 linear-feet on South University Avenue for the
8	frontage of the property which is part of the Mini-Warehouse Conditional Use Permit (Z-4578-B), located
9	at 1203-1205 South University Avenue. At time of right-of-way dedication, the row of vehicular parking
0	along South University Avenue for this property will be located within the public right-of-way.
1	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, o
2	word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
3	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
4	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
5	ordinance.
6	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with
7	the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
