17	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Crafton Tull &		
18	Associates, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Ten Thousand, Ninety-Five Dollars		
19	(\$210,095.00) for the Fourche Dam Pike Widening from Interstate 440 to south of Frazier Pike.		
20	Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a second agreement with Crafton Tull &		
21	Associates, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Twenty Thousand, One Hundred Five Dollars		
22	(\$220,105.00) for the Pratt Remmel Road Extension to Frazier Pike & Widening of Frazier Pike from west		
23	of Apple Drive to east of Zeuber Road; including Traffic Signal Improvements at Interstate 440 and Lindsay		
24	Road.		
25	Section 3. Funding for these projects are from US Department of Commerce – Economic Development		
26	Agency, the Delta Regional Authority and with local match funds from Pulaski County and City of Little		
27	Rock.		
28	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
29	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
30	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
31	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
32	resolution.		
33	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		

the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
