In order to accomplish this goal, the proposal is to purchase three (3) EOD 9 Bomb Suits for use by the Little Rock Fire Department Bomb Squad. The EOD 9 Bomb Suit is the current suit utilized and approved by Little Rock Fire Bomb Technicians, and therefore a sole-source purchase.</p> <p>100% of the funding is provided through the State Homeland Security Grant Program with no fiscal impact on the City of Little Rock.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>N/A</p> <p>Since September 11, 2001, the City has become eligible for several emergency service equipment grants. These purchases are eligible items from those grants.</p>
