3	A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH CASTILLO
4	CONCRETE POOL & SPA, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
5	NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED
6	NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$927,294.00), FOR THE INDIAN TRAIL
7	SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER
8	PURPOSES.

10	WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design sidewalk
11	improvements along Indian Trail between Glen Drive and Mohawk Circle; and,
12	WHEREAS, project improvements include construction of concrete sidewalks and associated
13	combination curb and gutter, access ramps, drainage improvements and retaining walls where necessary
14	and related work; and,
15	WHEREAS, there were four (4) responses to an Invitation to Bid ("ITB"), Bid No. 3026 for Indian
16	Trail Sidewalk; and,
17	WHEREAS, it was determined that Castillo Concrete Pool & Spa, Inc, provided the lowest responsive
18	and responsible bid meeting specifications.
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
20	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
21	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the Indian Trail
22	Sidewalk project with Castillo Concrete Pool & Spa, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred
23	Twenty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars (\$927,294.00), which is the base bid amount
24	of Seven Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$772,745.00), plus a twenty
25	percent (20%) contingency, if needed.
26	Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Little
27	Rock, Ark. Resolution No. 15,968 (May 2, 2023), with funds available from Account Activity B3D023S.
28	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
29	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
30	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
31	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
32	resolution.
