



1 (5) This article regulates the construction of flood barriers which unnaturally divert  
2 floodwaters or which may adversely impact other lands. *Flood damage prevention*  
3 *code adopted by reference*. There is hereby adopted by reference a "Flood Damage  
4 Prevention Code for the City of Little Rock, Arkansas," dated June 7, 2019. The  
5 Code shall include:

6 Article 1 Definitions;

7 Article 2 Administration;

8 Article 3 Provisions for Flood Hazard Reduction.

9 A copy of the referenced Code shall be filed in the office of the Pulaski County  
10 Circuit Clerk and shall be available for inspection and copying during normal  
11 business hours.

12 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
13 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
14 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and  
15 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the  
16 resolution.

17 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with  
18 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

19 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to maintain a consistent Property Maintenance Code*  
20 *applicable to readily identifiable properties is essential to the public health, safety and welfare; an*  
21 *emergency is, therefore, declared to exist so this ordinance can take effect, and be in full force and effect,*  
22 *from and after June 7, 2019.*
