15	amount of Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000.00) to demolish and remove these structures.		
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
17	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
18	Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the abandonment and demolition of the ten (10)		
19	structures identified in Exhibit A for a total amount not to exceed Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars		
20	(\$95,000.00)		
21	Section 2. Funds for this program are available from Demolition Account Number 108359.		
22	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
23	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adju-		
24	dication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and ef-		
25	fect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
26	resolution.		
27	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances and resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of		
28	this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
