

**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE IT IMPRACTICAL AND UNFEASIBLE TO BID; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SOLE-SOURCE CONTRACT TO RENEW SERVICES WITH LEADSONLINE, LLC, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY-EIGHT THOUSAND, FIVE-HUNDRED, AND FORTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$68,547.00), PLUS APPLICABLE TAXES AND FEES, FOR THE INTEGRATION OF THE RMS RECORDS SYSTEM IN THE REAL TIME CRIME CENTER AT THE LITTLE ROCK POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 18,952 (October 7, 2003) was incorporated into City Code 17-178, which requires all pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers and scrap metal yards to comply with online reporting of transactions; and,

**WHEREAS**, state statute requires electronic database record retention; and,

**WHEREAS**, the renewal of an existing contract makes it impractical and unfeasible to submit this matter to a competitive selection process; and,

**WHEREAS**, the total cost for a one (1)-year renewal of the software subscription services contract with LeadOnline, LLC shall not exceed Sixty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$68,547.00), plus applicable taxes and fees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1.** It is impractical and unfeasible to submit this one (1)-year renewal to the competitive process.

**Section 2.** The Board of Directors authorizes the City Manager to enter into a sole-source contract with LeadsOnline, LLC, in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$68,547.00), plus applicable taxes and fees, for the integration of the RMS Records Systems in the Real Time Crimes Center at Little Rock Police Department.

**Section 3.** Funding for these expenditures will be paid from Account No. 105201-61350.

**Section 4. *Severability.*** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication

1 shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the  
2 portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.

3 **Section 5. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with  
4 the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

5 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to have an automated single-source database collection*  
6 *point for information used by the pawn broker and resale industry is essential to the public health, safety*  
7 *and welfare; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect*  
8 *from and after the date of its passage.*
