<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A resolution to authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Weaver-Bailey, Inc., for ARDOT Project 061706 for the Interstate 440 at Fourche Dam Pike Interchange Improvement Project, Bid No. 1241.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$1,061,923.67, which is the base bid amount of \$884,936.39, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from a special \$1,000,000.00 grant of State Surplus Funds from the Governor’s Quick Action Fund in cooperation with the Arkansas Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration and the Arkansas Economic Development Commission with the local share and from the job recruitment – economic development set-aside in 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>This project provides intersection and signalization improvements including additional travel lanes for the Interstate 440 at Fourche Dam Pike Interchange in the Little Rock Port area. Weaver-Bailey, Inc., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of two (2) bids received for the project.</p>
