SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to amend Resolution No. 13,699, Sec.7., (a), (ii) adopted May 21, 2013, and to set forth additional projects for Ward 4 Street and Drainage Improvements.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>This resolution is an amendment to the existing list of approved improvement projects and there is no increase or decrease to the amount of funding allocated to Ward 4. Funding for the program is from the 3/8-Cent City Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds for Capital Improvements.</p>	
RECOMMENDATION	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
CITIZEN PARTICIPATION	<p>The original resolution setting forth improvement projects for each Ward was adopted after a series of fourteen (14) Ward meetings. This amendment concerning the Pleasant Valley Roundabout project is proposed after a series of two (2) public meetings to present draft designs for the project.</p>	

BACKGROUND

The Pleasant Valley Roundabout project was an element of the 2013 Capital Improvement Bond Plan previously-endorsed by the Board at the May 21, 2013 meeting, Res. No. 13,699.

This resolution sets forth an amendment to the original project list. Staff recommends the addition of sidewalk work in the vicinity of Terry Elementary School at Shackleford Road and Mara Lynn Road and that an engineering study be implemented to develop a plan for possible future improvements to Rodney Parham Road from Hinson Road to Cantrell Road, and that these projects be added to the Ward 4 Capital Improvement Program.
