<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>This resolution authorizes an additional year of software maintenance services for the City's IBM mainframe computer pursuant to sole-source Ordinance No. 20,220 (February 16, 2010).</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>The total cost for this service is \$147,888.00 plus taxes. The funds for this purchase have been appropriated from the Information Technology Operations Account No. 103030 – 61320 and 108309-61320-S30A396.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<b>CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</b>	<p>N/A</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>The City uses an IBM Mainframe Computer to manage its database systems for the Little Rock Police Department, Treasury Management, Parking Enforcement, District Courts and the Vehicle Storage Facility. Operation of the mainframe requires IBM Operating System Software. The software license requires that all maintenance services for the IBM mainframe software must be performed by IBM Corporation.</p>

Therefore, to avoid termination of the mainframe software license, the City must extend its agreement with IBM Corporation for mainframe software maintenance services.
