SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Construction Services Contract with Township Builders for the construction of a new trail at MacArthur Park.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>The City of Little Rock was awarded a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Grant in 2015, which will be used to help fund construction of this project. Payment for the contract will not exceed \$139,375.00 and will be funded from MacArthur Park Safe Routes to School Grant Fund, Account No. 270459-G23119 in the amount of \$96,329, from a donation from the MacPark Group, Account No. 270459-G23119 in the amount of \$5,000 and the remainder from Account No. 210459-S45B638.</p>

BACKGROUND	<p>This contract is for the Construction Services for a new asphalt trail on the south side of Interstate 630 from MacArthur Park. The ten (10)-foot wide trail will run from just east of Main Street to Rockefeller Elementary School.</p>
