SYNOPSIS	The ordinance amends Article I, Section 34-4, Definitions, of the Transportation Code to change the age limitations of executive sedans, extended vans, luxury vehicles, and SUVs.

BACKGROUND	As permitted ground transportation service vehicles are aging, staff is receiving more requests to extend the applicable removal date. Over the past several years, poor economic conditions have financially affected some ground transportation service operators' ability to replace their ground transportation service vehicles after the 8 th model year, as required by the current Transportation Code. In some cases, the vehicle had reached the removal point; however, the vehicle was in excellent condition.

**BACKGROUND
CONTINUED**

Ground transportation service operators are more than willing to replace their ground transportation service vehicles, as required by the Transportation Code, but usually need a one (1) or two (2)-year extension in most cases. The proposed ordinance will extend the serviceable life of the vehicle under the Transportation Code.
