SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a Subaward grant agreement with the Arkansas Tri-Region Energy and Environment Innovation Coalition to receive grant funding for the conversion of High-Pressure Sodium Streetlight bulbs to LED fixtures.	
FISCAL IMPACT	No local match funds are required for this opportunity.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The City of Little Rock currently has 871 high-pressure sodium streetlight bulbs, which are not energy efficient, and for which replacement parts are being discontinued. This Subaward grant will provide funding to convert these existing streetlights to energy-efficient LED fixtures. The LED fixtures will save approximately 1,000,000 kwh annually, which is enough energy to power 100 homes for one year.
