SYNOPSIS	The CDBG-DR Action Plan delineates the uses of the CDBG-DR allocation for the Presidentially Declared Disaster areas of the city during March 31, 2023, tornado. This Board action approves the submission of the CDBG-DR Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
FISCAL IMPACT	The City is eligible to receive a CDBG-DR allocation of \$20,895,000.00 in disaster recovery funds for necessary expenses for activities authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 <i>et. seq.</i>) related to disaster relief, long-term recovery, restoration of infrastructure and housing, economic revitalization, and mitigation.
