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3 **A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF**
4 **LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID FUNDS FOR**
5 **THE 12TH STREET JUMP START IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AND**
6 **FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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8 **WHEREAS**, Metroplan has recently approved Federal-aid Surface Transportation Block Grant

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18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
19 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, THAT:**

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21 **Section 1.** The City will participate in accordance with its designated responsibilities in this project.

22 **Section 2.** The Mayor, City Manager, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized and
23 directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of this
24 City project.

25 **Section 3.** The City pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of
26 Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.

27 **Section 4.** Funding for the City share of the project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales
28 and Compensating Use Tax Funds, designated Grant Match Accounts, and future 2018 Capital
29 Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage.

30 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
31 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
32 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
33 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
34 resolution.

1 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
