<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	Authorizes the City Manager to execute a supplement to the Agreement of Understanding with ARDOT for Job 061510 to increase the amount of the City's contribution to allow for the replacement of lightning-damaged equipment and cost escalations.	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	The amount of the requested increase is \$552,380.00, for a total contribution of \$1,152,380.00, and funding is allocated in the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds as authorized by Little Rock, Ark. Resolution No. 14,803 (June 19, 2018). Account No. TS0B129.	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	Approval of the resolution.	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	Authorized by Resolution 14,458 (December 6, 2016), the City of Little Rock entered into an AOU with the ARDOT for the implementation of Job 061510, Highway 70 / Highway 5 / University Avenue Intersection Improvements, and agreed to contribute \$600,000.00 towards the overall cost of the project. Lightning subsequently damaged equipment in the intersection, and ARDOT is asking the City to increase its contribution to cover the cost of additional work items and a 50% portion of the estimated cost escalations.
