SYNOPSIS	From April 2 – 22, 2025 the City of Little Rock experienced significant damage from a series of severe storms producing large amounts of vegetative debris

BACKGROUND	On May 3, 2025, Arkansas Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders requested a major disaster declaration from President Donald J. Trump as a result of the severe storms from April 2 – 22. On May 23, 2025, President Donald J. Trump approved the major disaster declaration for certain counties in Arkansas including Pulaski County. On May 29, 2025, following the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) applicant briefing with the City of Little Rock Emergency Management team, it was determined that the City is eligible for financial assistance provided the City employs a debris removal monitor to oversee aspects of the recovery work. Time is of the essence to enter into these contracts and to assure that the disaster recovery work is continued in an	

expedited fashion.
