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WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design pedestrian improvements to allow bus passengers to safely access bus stops adjacent to the cycle track along 7th Street between South Cross Street and Wolfe Street; and,

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received on July 1, 2025, in response to Invitation to Bid (“ITB”) No. 3040 for 7th Street Bicycle Ramps, and it was determined that Wagner General Contractors, Inc., provided the lowest responsible and responsive bid; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 2. Funding for this project is from the ¾-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds as authorized by Little Rock, Ark. Resolution 14,803 (June 19, 2018) from Account Activity TS1B139.
