

1 **Section 2.** Funds for this program is available through the Community Programs Other Program
2 Support, Account No 108159-S15C515.

3 **Section 3.** Because of City Year’s unique approach with educational organizations in the area, the
4 Board of Directors declares it is impractical and unfeasible to submit this model to competitive bids.

5 **Section 4. *Severability.*** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
6 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
7 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
8 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
9 ordinance.

10 **Section 5. *Repealer.*** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
11 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

12 **Section 6. *Emergency Clause.*** *The ability to have an adequate educational model with members*
13 *properly equipped to interact effectively is essential to the public health, safety and welfare; an emergency*
14 *is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of*
15 *its passage.*
