SYNOPSIS	<p>An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with ICOR Technology for the purchase of two (2) ICOR Mini Tracked Robots for the Little Rock Police Department SWAT Team and the Little Rock Fire Department Bomb Squad.</p>

BACKGROUND	<p>The Emergency Management Division is committed to improving public safety throughout the City. Since September 11, 2001, the City has become eligible for several Emergency Service Equipment Grants, and the purchase of two (2) ICOR Mini Tracked Robots for the Little Rock Police Department SWAT Team and the Little Rock Fire Department Bomb Squad are eligible items from those grants.</p>
