<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>An ordinance to authorize the Acting City Manager to enter into a sole-source agreement with the Pulaski County Imagination Library to promote early childhood literacy.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Each month, Dolly Parton’s Imagination Library mails a high-quality, age-appropriate book to all children from birth to age five (5) who are enrolled in the program and books are sent regardless of a family’s income and at no cost to the child’s family, and each book is addressed to a child individually.</p> <p>The Pulaski County Imagination Library is responsible for enrolling children who live in Pulaski County and is solely responsible for securing funds to cover the cost of books and of their operations.</p> <p>As of July 31, 2025, the Pulaski County Imagination Library is providing a monthly individualized book to approximately 5,543 children who live in Little Rock, and they are the only entity that is able to adequately and efficiently provide an appropriate monthly individualized book to each registered child who lives in Little Rock</p>
