

1 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance
2 which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or
3 unconstitutional was not originally a part of this ordinance.

4 **Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with the
5 provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not lim-
6 ited to, Section 2 of Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 19,607 (October 3, 2006).

7 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The ability of an improvement district to comply with the statutory and*
8 *constitutional requirements of Arkansas law is essential to the public health, safety and welfare; the fact*
9 *that the Commissioners of this District are not currently fulfilling these required duties is an event which*
10 *much be corrected as quickly as possible; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance*
11 *shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
