11	WHEREAS, Pinnacle Consulting Management Group was selected through Professional Appraisal			
12	and Acquisition Services process under Bid No. 18,176, and was awarded a contract for services to appraise			
13	and acquire right-of-way; and,			
14	WHERAS, it is desirable to increase the contract ceiling prices to provide for additional services for			
15	the 2019 - 2021 Street and Drainage Improvement Program.			
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY			
17	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:			
18	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve an amendment to the contract for			
19	Appraisals and Easement Acquisition and to increase the contract ceiling price from the previously-			
20	authorized amount of Forty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Dollars (\$49,900.00) by Three Hundred Fifty-			
21	One Dollars (\$351,000.00), to a new contract total of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00).			
22	Section 2. The cost for the contract will be funded from the existing project allocations for the 2018			
23 24	Capital Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage and the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and			
24 25	Compensating Use Tax for constructing of Street and Drainage Improvement Projects as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803 (June 19, 2018).			
25 26	Section 3. <i>Severability</i> . In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or			
27	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
28	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
29	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the			
30	resolution.			
31	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with			
32	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
