SYNOPSIS	A resolution to adopt the 2025 Sustainability Action Plan as recommended by the Little Rock Sustainability Commission (LRSC). The Plan provides strategies and measurable goals to promote energy efficiency, expand sustainable transportation options, reduce waste, preserve natural resources, and foster community-wide environmental awareness.	
FISCAL IMPACT	There is no direct fiscal impact associated with adopting the Plan. Future initiatives arising from the Plan may require funding and will be presented individually to the Board of Directors for consideration.

BACKGROUND	The Little Rock Sustainability Commission (LRSC) was created in 2008 as a Mayoral task force and was formally established as a City commission through Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 21,632 (September 18, 2018). The Commission is responsible for advising the City on policies and strategies to advance environmental and economic sustainability. The LRSC has prepared the 2025 Sustainability Action Plan to serve as a framework for energy efficiency, sustainable transportation, waste reduction, natural resource conservation, and public engagement.
