SYNOPSIS  FISCAL IMPACT	An ordinance to amend the Little Rock City Code, Rev. (1988) ("LRC") § 2-242(e)(1) to remove the requirement for professional service contracts of \$5,000 or less to be reviewed by the City's Board of Directors ("Board").  None	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the Ordinance.	
BACKGROUND	LRC § 2-242(e)(1) requires the City Manager to provide the Mayor and members of the Board a list of the professional services contracts that are anticipated to be under \$50,000.00 each week. This applies to all such contracts, even those which are small or "no cost" contracts. LRC § 2-243(i) waives the requirement for a review committee for contracts of \$5,000 and less and allows a department director to send them directly to the City Manager for review and approval or disapproval.  Removing the requirement for Board approval for small professional services will streamline the contracts process and make the City's contracting procedures more efficient.
