4	THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR AMBULANCE SERVICES	
5	BETWEEN THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS AND PULASKI	
6	COUNTY, ARKANSAS, GRANTING THE LITTLE ROCK AMBULANCE	
7	AUTHORITY D/B/A METROPOLITAN EMERGENCY MEDICAL	
8	SERVICES AN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE	
9	AMBULANCE SERVICES TO PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND	
10	FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

12	WHEREAS, the Little Rock Ambulance Authority ("LRAA") d/b/a Metropolitan Emergency	
13	Medical Services ("MEMS") currently holds an exclusive franchise to provide all ambulance services	
14	(emergency and non-emergency) to Pulaski County, Arkansas per an interlocal agreement between the	
15	City of Little Rock and Pulaski County, Arkansas ("Interlocal Agreement"); and,	
16	WHEREAS, the original five (5) year Interlocal Agreement had a term from October 27, 2015 to	
17	October 27, 2020 and was extended by an additional five (5) year term to expire on October 27, 2025; and	
18	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock and Pulaski County wish to extend said Interlocal	
19	Agreement for a second five (5) year term through October 27, 2030; and,	
20	WHEREAS, MEMS has represented to this Board that it has the capability and resources to	
21	provide such service without increasing expenses or rates for Little Rock citizens; and,	
22	WHEREAS, this Board believes that it is beneficial to continue to have MEMS provide	
23	ambulance services to Pulaski County, Arkansas and thereby promote the health and welfare of the	
24	citizens of Little Rock, Arkansas and Pulaski County, Arkansas; and,	
25	WHEREAS, the delivery of ambulance services (emergency and non-emergency) to Pulaski	
26	County, Arkansas will enhance MEMS' financial soundness and increase its ability to deliver high-	
27	quality emergency medical services to all citizens.	
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE	
29	CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:	
30	Section 1. The Board hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a second five (5) year extension	
31	of the interlocal agreement between the City of Little Rock, Arkansas and Pulaski County, Arkansas. Said	
32	interlocal agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit #1 and the first extension thereto is attached hereto as	
33	Exhibit #2.	

1	Section 2. Severability. In the event any portion of this resolution is declared or adjudged to		
2	invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of th		
3	resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid		
4	unconstitutional was not originally a part of this resolution.		
5	Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict wi		
6	any provision of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
