8	WHEREAS, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas ("City") has elected to use a rotation basis for			
9	Contract Wrecker Service; and,			
10	WHEREAS, after a competitive selection process, four (4) companies have been deemed to b			
11	responsible and responsive bidders to the City's Request for Qualifications ("RFQ"); and,			
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY			
13	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:			
14	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into Towing Service Contracts with:			
15	A. Metro Towing & Recovery, LLC			
16	B. Asher Wrecker Service, Inc.			
17	C. Adams Towing, Inc.			
18	D. East End Towing, Inc.			
19	Section 2. The term of these towing service contracts shall be from 12:01 AM, October 1, 2019,			
20	through September 30, 2020. If the City and all contract wrecker companies agree, the term may renewed			
21	two (2) times in one (1)-year increments by fully-executed addendum to each Towing Service Contract no			
22	less than ninety (90) calendar days prior to expiration of the then-current term. The first renewal term			
23	shall be from 12:01 AM, October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021; and the second renewal term			
24	shall begin 12:01 AM, October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022.			
25	Section 3. The terms and conditions of these towing service contracts shall be consistent with the			
26	RFQ specifications, and the agreements shall be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney in order to			
27	ensure that the City's interests are met.			
28	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or			
29	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or			
30	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
31	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the			
32	resolution.			
33	Section 5. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with			

the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
