<p><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the Mayor to execute a contract with CHI St. Vincent Medical Group for the provision of Health Care Services to low-income individuals residing in the City of Little Rock.</p> <p>The City receives Community Development Block Grant Funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development in the amount of \$175,000.00.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>In June, the City of Little Rock Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 14,798, approving the sources and uses of the 2018 CDBG, HOME and HOPWA Funds. The uses of the 2018 Community Development Block Grant Funds included an allocation for CHI St. Vincent Infirmary, Carelink, and Mainstream Independent Living Services.</p> <p>Consistent with the City’s adopted Citizen Participation Plan, the Consolidated Planning Committee recommended the sources and uses of the City’s 2018 Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds.</p>
