<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>To authorize the execution of documents to enter into the National League of Cities Prescription Discount Program for citizens of the City.</p> <p>None.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The National League of Cities (NLC) has set up the NLC Prescription Discount Program with CVS Caremark. This program enables citizens to obtain an average 24% discount on prescription medicines if purchased from any of the 68,000 participating pharmacies. In Little Rock, there are four (4) CVS stores that will honor this card; however, many other pharmacies and major chains also honor the card. There is no cost to the City; however, NLC tracks usage and savings on an annual basis so that information is available to the City.</p> <p>Currently, the municipalities of Benton, Bryant, Eureka Springs, Hot Springs, and North Little Rock, all participate in this program.</p>
