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10	WHEREAS, Bids were solicited for construction of improvements and extensions to the Little Rock
11	Landfill Gas Collection System, Bid No. 596; and,
12	WHEREAS, Advanced Fluid Technologies, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting
13	specifications.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
15	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
16	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Advanced Fluid
17	Technologies, Inc., for Landfill Gas System Expansion in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand,
18	Three Hundred Forty-Four and 26/100 Dollars, (\$200,344.26), which is the base bid amount of One
19	Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty-Three and 55/100 Dollars (\$166,953.55), plus 20%
20	contingencies.
21	Section 2. Funding for this project is from a Special Capital Improvement Activity in the Solid Waste
22	Enterprise Fund.
23	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
24	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
27	resolution.
28	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
29	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
