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11	WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the Kanis Road Improvement Project from Shackleford Road to		
12	Embassy Drive, Bid No. 18-021; and,		
13	WHEREAS, Burkhalter Technologies, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting		
14	specifications.		
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
16	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
17	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Burkhalter		
18	Technologies, Inc., for the Kanis Road Improvement Project from Shackleford Road to Embassy Drive in		
19	an amount not to exceed Four Million, Two Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand, Four Hundred Thirty-Four		
20	and 68/100 Dollars (\$4,248,434.68), which is the base bid amount of Three Million, Five Hundred Forty		
21	Thousand, Three Hundred Sixty-Two and 23/100 Dollars (\$3,540,362.23), plus 20% contingencies.		
22	Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating		
23	Use Tax Funds and the 2012 Capital Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage authorized by		
24	Resolutions No. 13,699 and No. 14,269.		
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
26	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
27	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
28	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the		
29	resolution.		
30	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
31	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
