



In accordance with its Citizen Participation Plan, the City of Little Rock has four public meetings schedule to address housing and community development needs for the FY 2023 Annual Action Plans. The purpose of the meetings is to obtain the views and comments of individuals and organizations relative to the needs that may be addressed by CDBG, HOME, and HOPWA funds. With the announcement of Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) under

CDBG, the public hearings are also scheduled to give citizens an opportunity to provide suggestions for proposed projects that may be eligible for funding under 2023 CDBG Program. Application for CDBG projects will be available on **October 3, 2022**. The plan also relies on the opinions and experiences of people who are knowledgeable about housing and community development in Little Rock – people like you.
