

LITTLE ROCK POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Violent crime down 6% and property crime down 3%.Overall crime is down 4%.
- Received gold standard recognition from the Commission of Accredited Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA).
- Developed a Community Response
 Team composed Crisis Intervention trained officers and social workers.

PUBLIC WORKS

- 70 new street and drainage projects in progress
- Received \$4.5 million in grant funding for the following projects:
 - Jonesboro Children's Trail Phase 3
 - Bowman Road Phase 2 STBG
 - Arkansas River Trail STBG
 - South Broadway Safety
 - Markham Streets Sidewalks
 - 1-30 Deck Park Feasibility

LITTLE ROCK FIRE DEPARTMENT

- Acquired temporary property for Station 9 and land to begin development of Fire Station 25
- Put several new vehicles into service and smartly reduced fuel consumption for more eco-friendly operations.
- Provided body cameras for fire marshals to elevate accountability and safety.

PARKS & RECREATION

- Secured over \$400,000 in grant funding and donations for special park projects and improvements.
- Completed improvements at Rebsamen Tennis
 Center that included the resurfacing of four courts and new sports lights for courts.
- Established Rose Creek Park as the 64th official City Park.
- Secured funding for new playground equipment to be installed in Spring 2024 at:
 - Boyle Park, Pankey Park, & Kiwanis Park

911 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS

- Increased call answer rate from 42% to 92%; a large leap toward the national average of 95%.
- Implemented new call-taking system to improve performance and provide new insights that will expand the department's productivity.
- Implemented \$2,500 sign-on bonus

PORT & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- In five years, the \$30 million investment into economic development at the Port of Little Rock has resulted in a \$831 million capital investment
- 11,000 new jobs in Little Rock
