

PARKS RULES & GUIDELINES

Park Hours

- All parks are open from **6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.** unless otherwise posted.
- After-hours presence in any park is prohibited without a formal permit.

Gates and Park Access

- If a gate to a park is locked **during normal operating hours**, please report it immediately to 311 or contact Little Rock Parks & Recreation at **(501) 371-4770**.

Parking Rules

- Vehicles must remain on paved roads or designated parking areas.
- Parking on grass, sidewalks, trails, or within natural areas is strictly prohibited.

Amplified Sound

- Amplified music or public address systems are **not allowed** without a special event permit. (City of Little Rock Ordinance #7022)

Smoking

- Smoking and tobacco use are not allowed within park boundaries.

Guns

- No guns are allowed in the parks.

Food and Picnicking

- Picnicking is welcome in all public parks on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Grilling is permitted **only** in designated grill stations or with a **portable grill** that is elevated off the ground.
- Crawfish boils or dinners are not allowed in Little Rock Parks.
- Open flames on the ground, bonfires, or fire pits are not allowed.
- Food trucks must be approved and permitted through Little Rock Parks & Recreation. Contact **(501) 371-4770** for more information.

Reporting Maintenance Issues

- To report damaged equipment, unsafe conditions, or cleanliness concerns, call **311**.

Encounters with Unsheltered Individuals

- Parks are public spaces, and individuals experiencing homelessness are allowed to be in the park as long as they follow the same rules as all visitors.
- If you observe illegal activity, safety concerns, or situations requiring attention, contact the **Little Rock Police Department non-emergency line** at **(501) 371-4829**.
