Did you know that **99%** of the materials in a car battery are recyclable?¹



New car batteries have **60-80%** recycled lead and plastic. **90%** of all car batteries purchased in the U.S. are recycled!²

Most batteries have high recyclable content, but don't recycle them in your residential recycling cart because they can cause explosions!
