Estimated Class: 120 minutes

City of Little Rock Friendly Driver Certification is earned upon demonstration of knowledge of technical course objectives.

Technical Course Objectives (TCO)

- TCO 1. Understand Arkansas and Little Rock laws for cyclists, pedestrians, and drivers.
- TCO 2. Know common practices for trained and untrained cyclists and pedestrians.
- TCO 3. Identify high risk areas within Little Rock for motor vehicle crashes involving pedestrians and cyclists
- TCO 4. Know rights and responsibilities for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers in various situations.
- TCO 5. Understand how to navigate bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure with and without bikes and pedestrians present.
- TCO 6. Understand how speed, impairment and awareness impacts sharing the road with cyclists and pedestrians
