

UHC Pharmacy Changes Effective May 1, 2020

For those of you enrolled in the City of Little Rock's United Healthcare Medical and Prescription Drug Plan, there will be an update in Pharmacy Benefits effective May 1, 2020. If you will be impacted by these changes, you will receive a letter in the mail from United Healthcare 30-60 days prior to the effective date of May 1, 2020. This should give you time to discuss with your doctor any medication changes.
